

Guidelines for the Author

Abstract

The papers should be developed and written in a symmetrical way of responding to a theme of seminar. Papers are acceptable in Hindi & English Language. Abstracts must pertain to original research works, either selfauthored or co-authored, and must not exceed 350 words. The abstract must include the title of the paper, objectives, methodology, keywords, the author's full name, address, e-mail and contact details. The title of the abstract should be capitalized. It should clearly mention the subject of the research work For the abstract, font style "Times New Roman" with size 12 and 1.5 line spacing should be followed. Abstract must contain only 3-5 keywords.

Full Length Paper

The Full-Length Paper must be between 3,000 to 5,000 words. Text should be printed in "Times New Roman" and "Krutu Dev" with font size 12 and 1.5 line spacing on an A4 (In MS Word) paper layout with standard margins. The paper should contain introduction, Review of Literature, Methodology, Results/Analysis and Conclusion. At the end of the paper, there should be a reference list in the latest edition of APA format.
